- A** Revolution in air travel. Instead of hanging around in crowded air terminals, enduring hours in cramped planes, eating junk food and watching soppy movies, passengers would be able to take the option of travelling as freight! For a fraction of the fare they can be anaesthetized at a local travel centre, transported to the airport and, while sleeping in a padded, air-conditioned casket, loaded onto a plane, whisked off to their destination and woken with a complimentary drink at the other end.
- B** Volkswagen will soon announce the first car made out of carbon-reinforced rubber with an internal floating passenger capsule. Tests have shown that even at impact of 160 km per hour the car simply bounces back to its original shape and the passengers (provided they are strapped in) remain a bit shaken but unhurt.
- C** Just imagine what can happen if cars will be driven by computers! The largest traffic pile-up ever recorded may occur just south of Los Angeles on the 28-lane Interstate Freeway and involve 720 cars. An electrical storm would cause all the in-car computers to fail. Thanks to carbon/rubber bodywork, no serious damage to vehicles will be reported and nobody will suffer more than a severe bouncing.
- D** The latest phone that looks like a wristwatch presented by Sieko at the Tokyo Hi-Tec exhibition features a button that when pressed can locate your position anywhere in the world to within a two-metre square. It will be essential equipment for adventurous travelers and dodgy taxi drivers.
- E** Sales of the Ford Gyrostar, a compact, family, solar-assisted helicopter, is predicted to outnumber those of Ford's land-limited vehicles in America by 2020. With onboard computer navigation, controlled by fully automated state flight control (no human error possible), there have been no fatal gyro accidents.
- F** Owing to the horrendous eco-damage from ever-increasing road grid, an ambitious plan being under consideration now is to put all Japanese transportation underground by 2037. It may be completed due to the gigantic trillion dollar Branson Tunneldiver, which can cut through the earth at the rate of 30 km per day. The new, pneumatic underground system may carry people at 300 kph in great comfort and at relatively small cost.
- G** Some scientists predict that if we think of ecology we should think of changing our thinking completely. For instance, by 2058 with help of new technology Britain may announce that pollution levels are one twentieth of what they were in the year 2000. This is largely due to all non-local road transport being safely underground and the recycling of industrial by-products before reaching the atmosphere.
